## Fireboat McKean Preservation Project

The John D. McKean proudly served the FDNY as Marine 1 in the heart of Manhattan for 58 years. On 9/11, it served NYC and the Nation by playing a crucial role in the immediate rescue of civilians fleeing the World Trade Center, and rushing back to Manhattan to aggressively pump water at maximum capacity to subdue the many fires burning on the pile. In January of 2009, it responded to Capt. "Sully" Sullenberger's emergency landing of US Airways flight # 1549 on the Hudson River, rescuing passengers and crew and best known as "The Miracle on the Hudson". Additionally, the McKean was honored to welcome participants of the NY Marathon yearly and host dignitaries from around the world visiting the city of New York.

After its retirement from the FDNY, this heroic vessel was sold at auction in 2016, and in 2018 the Fireboat McKean Preservation Project non-profit was formed to support restoration, preservation and public access for the John D. McKean. Thanks to generous partners, donors and hardworking volunteers, the boat was beautifully restored, and a major hull repair was completed in 2019. In 2023, the fireboat was named to the National Register of Historic Places, solidifying its place in history.

Our hope is that with your support of our golf event and other annual fundraising, additional restoration and on-going maintenance projects can be completed, and a highly visible, accessible location for public access can be established for all to come aboard and learn about the boat, its service, and the bravery of all who served aboard for decades to come.
